<b>(2)</b>	Lacks organization, logic, and clarity; address more than 1 pillar of NHS; directions not followed	Idea is cliché without anything added to set it apart from the typical storyline or idea	Shows minimal level of insight	Mostly simple sentences; simple word choice; more than or less than one page and not double spaced
<b>(1)</b>	Not organized or clear address more than 1 pillar of NHS; directions not followed	Idea is a copy of another work or is not a creative writing piece/personal essay	Shows lack of insight throughout paper; inability to perceive/interpret	Only simple sentences; inappropriate word choice; no adherence to directions
