This letter includes important information regarding any student who wishes to attend the Prom. The items below initiate prom eligibility; however, the final approval is determined by the Administration.

- 1. Student eligibility
- 2. Outside guest requirements

Prom tickets will cost \$170.00 per couple or \$85.00 for a single ticket. Tickets will be sold Tuesday, March  $22^{nd}$  through Thursday, March  $24^{th}$  in the Sterling High School auditorium during Junior/Senior lunch periods. Only seniors will be able to purchase tickets on Tuesday, March  $22^{nd}$ . Juniors and remaining seniors may purchase tickets on Wednesday and Thursday, March  $23^{rd}$ , and March  $24^{th}$ . ## TICKETS CANNOT BE PURCHASED UNLESS THESE REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET:

## 1. Student Eligibility:

 Any Sterling student who wishes to attend the prom must be in good standing with the Vice Principal's office regarding discipline and outstanding fines. If a student is not clear about his or her status, please contact Mr. Redman's office at (856) 784-1333, ext. 4141.

## 2. Outside Guest Requirements:

- Any student who wishes to bring an outside guest must submit Outside Guest Forms, which are due by Wednesday, March 16, 2022, to the Vice Principal's Office.
- Only Sterling High School students can submit cash/check for purchase of ticket. (**No outside** guest's checks will be accepted).
- If the guest attends another high school, that student must provide verification from his or her high school that they are in good standing and eligible to attend events such as prom.
- All guests must provide photo ID that has a Birthdate on it.
- Guests must be under 21 at the date of Prom (April 29<sup>th</sup>).
